

PrimeVAC[™] programs designed for transfer of calf health data.

PrimeVAC[™], from Merck Animal Health Canada, provides the tools to exchange vaccination, pre-conditioning and prevaccination status of calves between buyers and sellers. PrimeVAC[™]'s simple certification process facilitates the transfer of clearly defined cattle health information between buyers and sellers along the beef value chain.

PrimeVAC[™] programs are founded on the core principles: **vaccinating**, **pre-vaccinating** and **pre-conditioning**. Though widely discussed in the beef cattle industry, the terms pre-vaccinated and pre-conditioned are often used interchangeably or misunderstood.

Pre-vaccination: refers to vaccinating cattle 2-4 weeks prior to a high disease risk period or event such as weaning or transport when maximum immunity is required. This allows time for the cattle's immune system to function optimally and respond to a vaccine prior to the disease challenge.

Pre-conditioning: includes a group of time specific management components that together can reduce the risk of bovine respiratory disease. These components are:

- Pre-vaccination prior to weaning (against respiratory and clostridial pathogens)
- Calves weaned, minimum 45 days prior to sale
- All processing (castration/dehorning/branding) completed at least 3 weeks prior to transport
- Accustomed to eating from a bunk and drinking from a water bowl
